

Lizenzvereinbarung



ProntoTimer V2 / ProntoFlashMenu LICENSE AGREEMENT

This Software License Agreement ("Agreement") is made and effective by the date of the purchase of the software artefacts named in the header above.

Roth Mediatechnik (Developer) has developed and licenses to users its software program marketed under the name ProntoFlashMenu / ProntoTimer (the "Software") and is limited to the use of either a TSU9400 or a TSU9600/9800. The combined use can only be effective by buying both software artefacts.

The agreement is between Roth Mediatechnik ("Developer") and purchaser of the ProntoTimer and/or ProntoFlashMenu ("Licensee").

Licensee desires to utilize a copy of the Software.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, Developer and Licensee agree as follows:

1. License:

- Developer hereby grants to Licensee a perpetual, non-exclusive, limited license above to use the Software either as an end-user (private license) or a dealer (dealer's license).
- The software may be installed on all according Pronto TSU owned by the client as often as required
- You have not acquired the right to pass on the software to others
- You agree not to decompile this software

2. Restrictions

Licensee shall not modify, copy, duplicate, reproduce, license or sublicense the Software, or transfer or convey the Software or any right in the Software to anyone else without the prior written consent of Developer except for the dealer's licence, which will give you limited right to pass the software on. The Licensee; may make one copy of the Software for backup or archival purposes.

3. Fee

In consideration for the grant of the license and the use of the Software, Licensee agrees to pay Developer a one-time license fee outlined on the homepage of the developer. The fees on the homepage of the developer are binding. The price featured on the page at the moment of purchase is binding for 24 hours.

4. Warranty of Functionality

A. The developer warrants that the Software shall perform in all material respects according to the specifications lined out on Roth Mediatechnik homepage when used with the appropriate computer equipment (based on system and software requirements defined by the developer). This also means that the licensee has to be in compliance with the required minimal system requirements otherwise functionality is not warranted.

DEVELOPER'S WARRANTIES SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT ARE EXCLUSIVE AND ARE IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

7. Limitation of Liability

Developer shall not be responsible for, and shall not pay, any amount of incidental, consequential or other indirect damages, whether based on lost revenue or otherwise, regardless of whether Developer was advised of the possibility of such losses in advance. In no event shall Developer's liability hereunder exceed the amount of license fees paid by Licensee, regardless of whether Licensee's claim is based on contract, tort, strict liability, product liability or otherwise.

8. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the state of Zürich, Switzerland.

9. No Assignment

Neither this Agreement nor any interest in this Agreement may be assigned by Licensee without the prior express written approval of Developer.

10. Final Agreement

This Agreement terminates and supersedes all prior understandings or agreements on the subject matter hereof. This Agreement may be modified only by a further writing that is duly executed by both parties.

11. Severability

If any term of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, then this Agreement, including all of the remaining terms, will remain in full force and effect as if such invalid or unenforceable term had never been included.
